



## Presidents Cup Rules 2010

### 1. Teams

Both teams has 6 men and 2 women players. Also 1 man (from both divisions) and 1 woman must be nominated as a reserve player in case of injury or no-show. Players may be selected from older divisions as well. Players must live and have a passport in his/hers contingent (North America / Europe). Teams must name their players with numbers (From players no 1 to 6 in Men and 1 to 2 in women). Numbering takes place at the tournament center 1 hour before the tournament.

### 2. Groups

Presidents Cup will be played in four groups of four players. There are three Men groups and one women group. Group nr 1 tees off from hole 1 and other groups will follow them with 10 minute intervals.

### 3. Tournament phases

Presidents Cup consists two separate phases. Phase 1 is individual best shot on holes 1-7 and 17-18. Phase 2 is match play between numbered players on same holes. All players play 18 holes (unless the decision is made before that).

### 4. Point system

Players can earn points to their teams with following point system:

#### Round 1

Individual Best Shot (Men and Women, holes 1-7 and 17-18)

- \* Lowest score 4 points
- \* 2nd lowest score 2 points
- \* 3rd lowest score 1 point
- \* 4th lowest score 0 points

Ties split the points in question

#### Round 2

Match Play (Men and Women, holes 1-7 and 17-18)

Winner of a match play 3 points

Tie in a match = 1 1/2 points each

In case of a tie between teams after all holes played:

1 player Sudden Death on holes 1, 17, 18, 1, 17, 18...

Team captains will nominate the sudden death players.

The team who collects more points is the winner of President's Cup.
